



RESIDENTS: Are those who reside in the Towns of Madawaska and St. David.




Drop off your letter at the Multi Purpose Center Lobby during the day or in the outdoor mail box in the evening.




Beginners: The students will learn how to get up by themselves after they have fallen down. They will learn how to skate forwards and how to stop.
